PERMISSION ≠ SLIP is about turning away from external validation and reconnecting with what lives within us. It is a call to listen to intuition as our true compass and to trust it boldly, even when fear and societal pressure attempt to hold us in place. New paths, new ideas, and new realities can only be created when we release ourselves from the invisible grip of the system and allow instinct to lead.

The silhouettes are wide, monumental, and radically inclusive. They give space instead of enforcing control. Suit-inspired forms and uniform references echo professions and social structures, while folds, fluid volumes, and disrupted constructions dissolve their authority. Structure and softness exist side by side, constantly shifting, reflecting the tension between discipline and freedom.

Heavy and light 100 percent recycled PET materials give the garments weight, grounding the collection in physical presence while symbolizing the pressure of imposed systems. Prints are calmer and reduced, allowing handcrafted textures and finely woven print artworks to emerge. Raw edges become deliberate statements. All cutting waste is reused as decoration, twisted, fringed, and layered into new forms, exposing the process and breaking the uniform aesthetic open from the inside.

PERMISSION ≠ SLIP invites us to escape fear-driven choices and societal pressure in order to create something new. Each look functions as a personal declaration of self-authorship, translating inner truth into form. The collection is not about rejecting systems entirely, but about reclaiming agency within them and reshaping them through intuition.

Presented within an industrial environment that reflects circularity, recycling, and transformation, the show becomes an extension of the concept itself. Fashion, space, sound, and collaboration merge into a living system that questions control and celebrates the courage to choose oneself.

Rooted in trust in our own vision, PERMISSION ≠ SLIP disrupts established systems and builds new connections across disciplines that were never meant to stay separate.
